- (f) Why did the hunter give up his chase of his prey in Edmund Spencer's *Sonnet No. 67*?
- (g) What seemed strange to the hunter at the end of *Sonnet No. 67*?
- (h) Write the name of the Prioress. What is inscribed into her brooch?
- (i) In which volume was John Donne's poem, *The Sunne Rising* published and in which year?
- (j) What does the speaker imply when he refers to "th' Indias of spice and mine"?
- (k) What, according to the speaker, makes love stronger in Shakespeare's *Sonnet 73*?
- (l) "A torment thrice threefold thus to be crossed." How is the 'torment' 'thrice threefold'?
- (m) Name any two different fields of learning that Faustus considers before he turns to magic.
